What events have marked the development of this STS formation?

Three events reflect the development of Drexel CSTS over the last five years. The "Philadelphia Energy Futures" summit, organized by Drexel faculty and regional NGOs, highlights our engagement with local and regional issues, and partnerships beyond the university. The "Speculative Futures" workshop, organized by Vincent Duclos, drew scholars from around the world to discuss creative practices in health, technology and medicine in the global South. Most recently, Kelly Joyce in collaboration with sociolegal scholars, organized a two-day workshop, "Identifying Gaps, Building Bridges" to establish a new STS research network. Each event exemplifies work to build partnerships that can address, in different ways and at different scales, contemporary problems.
