

How is the future of this STS formation envisioned?

When asked about the future of the field and their own scholarship, many of our faculty referenced the “external conditions” described previously, such as machine learning, the Anthropocene, and data justice. Some underscored the importance of bringing more feminist, queer, and critical race theory into our research. Others pointed to the challenge of collaboration, and with it the importance of “retaining our legacy of critical engagement with the products of science/medicine/technology,” while also advocating for new and different kinds of STS products relevant to today’s needs.
