Dr. Nadine Tanio is the co-Founder and co-Director of UCL's Three Iris Center, a model of innovative research practice partnerships on epistemic justice and critical media production. She wrote *Subsidence and Transformational Pedagogy* and along with Fred Ariel Hernandez created the San Gabriel Research Institute. Nadine's research focuses on gender, diaspora, STEM and pedagogy and has sought to weave the divide between visual, digital and reading cultures. Her work bridges both academic research and popular media outlets, and has been influential in developing STEM (and STEAM) curricula for K-16 education. Nadine is best known for her award winning documentary *Justice without Mercy* which told the story of a small progressive school in the wake of Trump and the pandemic. Though the film was initially scorned by both conservatives and liberals active in school reform, it led to formation of the Weatherspoon Institute for Schools that has been the leading resource for K-12 educators seeking to sustainably support youth activism and equity in public and independent schools in California.

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
