



Keynote by Prof.dr. Sarah de Rijcke

Navigating the Metrics Maze
Fostering Responsibility in Academic Evaluation

In her upcoming keynote for the STUdieS Network, Sarah de Rijcke will examine the complex interactions between evaluation methods and the creation of knowledge within the higher education sector. She will discuss the growth of reform movements in the scientific community, with a particular emphasis on the responsible metrics movement. This movement underlines the significant and growing impact of quantitative performance indicators, advocating for a careful and ethical approach to using metrics in academic assessments. Sarah will describe how the concept of 'responsibility' is understood and implemented by the professionals that global reform efforts aim to engage.

Sarah de Rijcke is professor in Science, Technology, and Innovation Studies & dean of the Faculty of Social Sciences at Leiden University, the Netherlands. Sarah's long-term research interest is to examine the interactions between science governance and knowledge creation.
